- Ensure that I am in school on time, avoid taking holidays in school time and inform the school immediately if I am absent
- Support school in the teaching of safe and secure internet use and make sure that I take care with what I say and do online when I am at home, making sure I only use age appropriate social media
- Support my learning by working with me at home, and by attending meetings and workshops in school or accessing the resources via the school website/Google Classrooms
