- Where... *Are the pens?*
- Where... *Have you gone?*

Do not accept responses containing a grammatical error or non-standard form, eg:

- Where *is you going on holiday?*

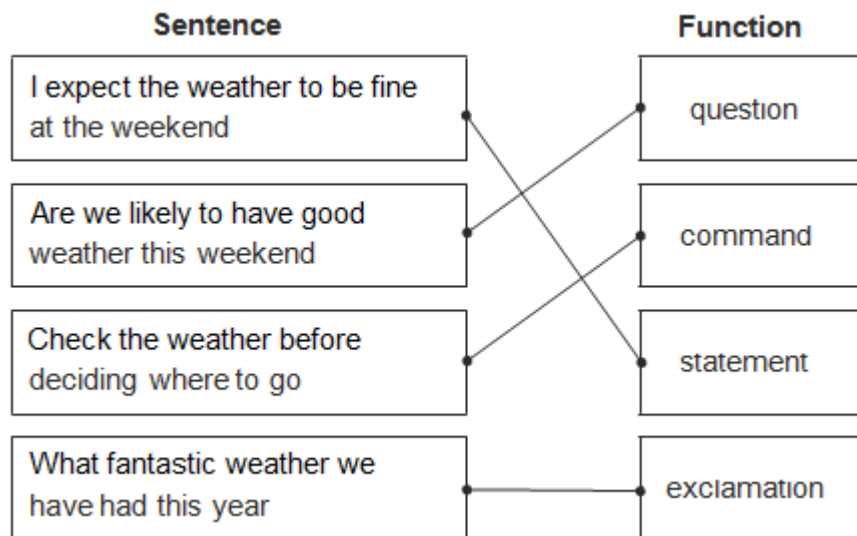

Do not accept the addition of a reporting clause resulting in a question contained within a statement, e.g.

Jane asked, "Is the band playing at the festival?"
