Writing Task 1: Can I write a diary from the P.O.V of a character?

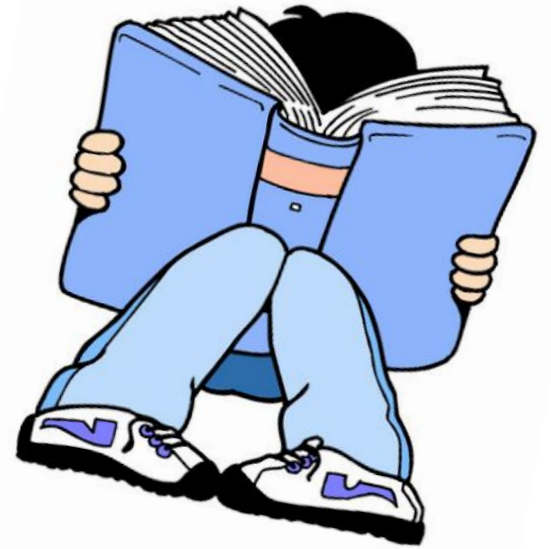
Put yourself in Fred's shoes. You've just survived a plane crash and landed in a strange and dangerous place.
