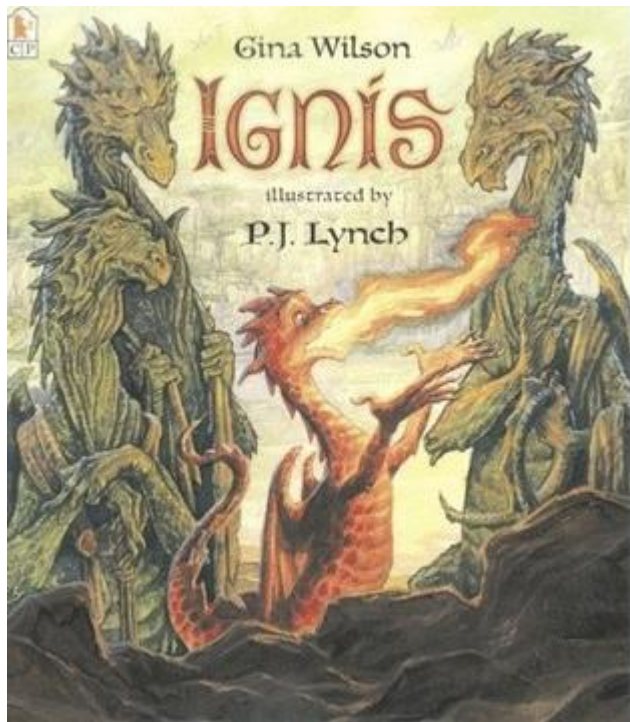


## Literacy session 2
