Here are some facts to help you: The **dragon** is a <u>legendary</u> <u>creature</u> belonging to the world of <u>mythology</u>, story telling and <u>fantasy</u>. There are <u>stories</u> about dragons in <u>Chinese</u> culture, <u>European</u> culture, South American culture, and many others.

Dragons can look like <u>dinosaurs</u> and other <u>extinct</u> animals. Because of that, it is easy to think that those animals might have been an example for dragons as they were thought of in the history of humankind.

There are many kinds of dragons in the different cultures. In general:

- A dragon has: four legs, claws, scales and possibly spikes and wings
- A dragon can look like a <u>snake</u> with <u>wings</u>, or like lizards
- A dragon has a tail and a long neck

- A dragon has a wide mouth with big and dangerous teeth
- Sometimes they have horns and hair
- A dragon can fly
- A dragon can breathe <u>fire</u>
- A dragon has special powers
- Some dragons live in caves
