A Morning in Reception

When you come into the classroom every morning, your teacher will greet you by the door. You will put your belongings away, choose your lunch and sign in with your name and picture. We will get together on the carpet for our learning input which might be counting, sharing a favorite story or finding out about different seasons! Every morning, you will be able to choose freely between a range of activities and you will also take part in exciting group activities with staff, such as phonics. We play outside every day and we also have fruit for a healthy mid-morning snack!

General Information

- You will need to bring in a water bottle into school each day, filled only with water.

- Just like in all other year groups, you will take home a reading for pleasure book to enjoy with your family. This book will be changed every Wedsnesday.
- ❖ You will get a yellow reading log for your grown-ups to record all of the lovely stories you have enjoyed at home. As you move through the phonics program your grown-ups can record all of the stories that you read to them. Your reading log needs to be in your bag everyday and will be checked on a Friday morning.
