



# CSE Warning Signs

<b>S</b> exual Health & Behaviour	Evidence of STI's, pregnancy and termination: inappropriate Sexualised behaviour
<b>A</b> bsent from school or MFH	Evidence of truancy or repeat incidents of missing from home/care
<b>F</b> amilial abuse/problems at Home	Familial sexual/emotional abuse, neglect, forced marriage, honour based violence, DA, substance misuse, parental mental health, family breakdown
<b>E</b> motional/Physical health	Thoughts of/or attempted suicide/self-harming, low self-esteem, problems relating to sexual orientation, learning difficulties, changes in appearance
<b>G</b> angs, older age groups and involvement in crime	Involvement in crime, older individuals or lacking friends of same age. Contact with others who are sexually exploited.
<b>U</b> se of technology and sexual bullying	Evidence of 'sexting', sexualised communication online or problematic use of internet and social networking sites.
<b>A</b> lcohol & Drug misuse	Problematic substance use
<b>R</b> eceipt of unexplained gifts or money	Unexplained finances, including phone credit, clothes & money
<b>D</b> istrust of authority figures	Resistance of communicating with parents, carers, teachers, social services health, police and other professionals.
