Year 1 - Welcome back! We hope that you all had a wonderful Summer break. The children have settled back into school life superbly and are quickly becoming used to the routines in Year 1. This week we have been writing our holiday news, talking about our families and ordering numbers to 10. The children have been busy exploring their classrooms and their new, bigger playground! In 1KS this week, we have been enjoying our fantastic new space and our brilliant new sensory activities! We are truly settled in now and have enjoyed drawing, making music, singing some of our favourite songs, and playing in the sunshine!

Can we please ask that all items of clothing, lunchboxes and water bottles are clearly named. Year 1 children will have outdoor PE on a Monday and indoor PE on a Friday. This will start

from Monday 9th September. If your child would like to bring their own snack into school each day, please ensure that it is a healthy snack - fruit, crackers, cereal bars etc. School does provide fruit each day and you can also purchase hot snack through Parent Pay, this must be paid for the night before.

This Week's Year Group News

KS2

Year 3 & 4 - What a fantastic first week back! It has been wonderful welcoming all our children back to school after the Summer, looking super smart and ready for the year ahead. We have kick started our learning straight away in English by writing expanded noun phrases and writing 'in role' as the character describing a setting. The children have already strived to use beautiful handwriting and choose high quality language choices! In Maths, Y3 and Y4 have begun their place value units by representing and partitioning numbers to 100 and 1000 in different ways. Y4 have discussed the importance of times tables this year and been introduced to URBrainy to support their recall. In the afternoons, we have studied Pablo Picasso and created our own pieces inspired by cubism. We worked with oil pastels, ink and markers to bring them alive! They are going to make a fantastic, colourful display in our corridors once finished.

Reminder - Your child will have brought home their reading diary today. Our children are expected to read at least 3 times per week and this should be recorded by an adult in their reading log. Please remind your child that reading logs should be returned to school each Friday so they can be rewarded for their efforts. We encourage children to read widely as well as books. This could include age appropriate newspapers, magazines, menus, recipes or road signs.

Year 5 & 6 - Welcome back everyone! The Year 5/6 team are incredibly proud of all children for doing such a fantastic job during their first week back in school. Their behaviour has been outstanding and we wish to thank all children in 5RO, 5SE, 5/6LT, 6AW and 6DM for this amazing start - keep it up team! This week in English, we made predictions and asked questions about our new class text 'Lost Happy Endings' based on the front cover and the blurb. Then, we read the beginning of the text and created expanded noun phrases to describe one of the amazing illustrations. In Maths, we have revised our times tables and recalled what we could remember about the four operations: addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We have also begun our place value units, with Y5 focusing on Roman numerals and Y6 focusing on partitioning numbers up to 6-digits. In the afternoons this week, we have created some 'forest scenes' inspired by our new English text. We have also been introduced to a fascinating explorer: Ranulph Fiennes and began our first COJO's mission, focusing on world records!

Whole School Attendance 96.73% Reporting Children's Absence

School must be informed of children's absence on the first day by ringing 0151 329 3164 and pressing 1 to leave a message. This must be done before 9am. Please ensure you provide the child's name, class and reason for absence.

If your child is absent due to sickness or diarrhoea, they will be unable to return to school for 48hrs after their last episode. This is inline with the Public Health Agency guidance to reduce the risk of the illness spreading.

Any absence not explained is registered as unauthorised.

Appointments

Parents and carers should make every effort to book routine dental and GP appointments outside of school hours. Where this is not possible, children should only be absent for the time needed for the appointment and travel to and from.

For any prebooked medical appointments copies of appointment letters can be emailed to n.brown@woodlands.cheshire.sch.uk in advance so that a note can be added to the register. The school will work with all families on an individual basis if medical absences exceed the maximum threshold.

Holidays During Term Time

Can we politely request that parents inform school of any upcoming holidays via the Leave of Absence forms which can be collected from the school offices. These forms should be completed and handed to school 4 working weeks in advance of the first day of absence. We aim to reply to you within 10 working days of your application.

Uniform Standards Reminder

Please discuss the following with your child regarding appropriate standards in school:

Uniform consists of a green sweatshirt or cardigan, white polo shirt, shirt or blouse, grey trousers, skirt or pinafore dress. During the warmer months, children may wear green gingham dresses or grey shorts. Uniform is not compulsory for our Nursery children. Please send children to school in sensible black school shoes. No trainers, boots, slip-on or heeled shoes please, as these are not suitable for outdoor play. Make-up, jewellery (with the exception of small stud earrings) and fake nails are not permitted. Sunglasses should be removed in school and not worn on the head.

Please be reminded that your child's PE kit to be worn to school on PE days. This should consist of a plain white T-shirt, black shorts/leggings/jogging bottoms and black tracksuit/sweatshirt top (no football kits or bright colours) and sensible trainers or indoor pumps. Please can we remind you that expensive, branded items are not encouraged as they can easily be lost or damaged and places unnecessary pressures on other parents. For Nursery, leisurewear and suitable shoes are acceptable.

Please label all items as it can be upsetting for children when items are lost.

Dear Parents,

I am delighted to inform you that following the success of previous year's courses we are expanding the football coaching programme for the season. The course will run on a weekly basis EVERY MONDAY during school term times.

All of our courses are run by F.A. QUALIFIED COACHES INCLUDING EX-PROFESSIONAL PLAYERS. All of our coaches have been DBS/CRB POLICE CHECKED. The course is open to boys and girls aged between 4 and 12. All abilities are catered for with total beginners introduced through FUN and confidence building practices. The course is tightly structured to ensure all aspects of football skills are developed.

At the end of the term(usually 10-15 weeks) every child will receive an engraved merit trophy and course certificate, with chances to win extra trophies including penalty shoot out, american shoot out and champions league competitions.

The cost of the course is £7.50 per week, which is payable every four weeks (£30) with the first payment due on week one. Parents are welcome to stay and watch however the club is fully supervised so children may be left in our care. We have the use of excellent facilities including the large sports hall and outdoor pitches.

A prospectus available on the night will give you further information, and you will be more that welcome to contact the school and visit us again if you need to do so.


