#### This Week's Year Group News

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#### **EYFS**

Squirrels - Thanks to everyone who brought in Autumn objects this week, from your woodland walks! The children have enjoyed showing Squirrels what they have found and we have looked at all the lovely colours on the leaves, pine cones and twigs. The vocabulary used was fantastic, such as 'spikey, long, tiny and hard'. We are going to make a woodland activity with these collections and use our woodland animal puppet sticks to explore and further develop our language skills. Please keep these coming in and also any photos you would like to share. This week, we have also continued exploring our emotions and feelings. We have played games such as 'guessing the feelings' to match given faces. Some of the children even knew the emotions 'nervous', 'sleepy' and 'shocked'. Well done Squirrels. Thank you very much for all the donations of some spare clothes. We have a lovely topped up box for emergencies.

Foxes - Another busy week in Foxes! This week, we have completed our work around 'The Gingerbread Man' story and we have enjoyed re-telling the story together. We have also been thinking about Autumn and what happens around us this time of year. The children have been busy sorting Autumn leaves, conkers and pine cones into different sets and we have also had fun making simple patterns with Autumnal objects. Foxes enjoyed creating some beautiful harvest pictures, painting and printing with different fruits and vegetables. Well done Foxes! Foxes@woodlands.cheshire.sch.uk

Badgers & Owls - This week, we received a letter from 'Mrs Baker' (Gingerbread Man character) asking us to design a cake! The children have enjoyed designing their tasty cakes and have used their sounds to label them. We have also created story maps to retell the story of 'The Gingerbread Man'. In Maths, we have been looking at patterns. We have continued repeating patterns and have even created our own. Well done Owls and Badgers, another great week!

Acorns - This week, the children in Acorns have continued exploring the story of 'The Gingerbread Man' and revisiting the characters in the story, we are getting very good at singing our gingerbread rhyme. We have also enjoyed making 'Gingerbread Man' suncatchers in Art, which all look fabulous! Our focus and joint attention during activities is improving every week and we are even starting to hear different sounds and words from all the children - well done Acorns!

#### <u>KS1</u>

Year 1 - 1AA & 1LW - What a busy week! This week, in English, we have written our own versions of 'Troll Swap', trying to remember to use finger spaces, capital letters and full stops. In Maths, we have been recapping 2D and 3D shapes. We have described shapes, sorted them and looked for them in our classroom. We have also looked at repeating patterns. In Science, we talked about signs of Autumn and went on an Autumnal walk in the school grounds. We continued to talk about our local area in Geography and thought about what new landmarks we would like to see in Ellesmere Port. A reminder that next week is our Harvest Assembly on Thursday morning at 9.15 (Parents & Carers welcome). If you would like to donate any non-perishable food goods, we will be making a donation to the local food bank. In 1KS this week, we have continued to practice our 'M, A, S, T, D' sounds, recognising, speaking and writing them. We have hopped, jumped and danced along to some movement videos in PE and we've enjoyed role playing with the dolls house, furniture and food. We've been counting paper leaves in Maths and playing with lots of real ones outside! Finally, in Art we have prepared our Christmas card designs which will be available for families to buy after half term. The finger painting was so much fun!

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#### This Week's Year Group News

#### KS1 Continued...

Year 2 - In English, we have continued to use the wonderful 'Troll Swap' to inspire our work. The children have been writing character descriptions for their new characters and they have continued to learn about conjunctions and how to use 'because' to connect sentences. The children have also been learning to spell words with the prefix 'un' and the suffixes 'er' and 'est'. In Mathematics, the children have started to learn about addition and subtraction using two 2-digit numbers. As part of our Science work on animals, including humans, the children have been leaning about the importance of exercise. In Geography, we have been learning about the countries that make up the United Kingdom and the capital cities too.

#### **KS2**

Year 3 & 4 - In English this week, Y3/4 have been writing diary entries in role as 'Hannah' from our narrative, 'Gorilla.' We thought carefully about the features of diary writing and tried to include many of these in our own work. Initially, we wrote a draft copy which allowed us to proof read and edit our writing to improve our noun phrases or sentence starters (fronted adverbials). Once we had made changes, we copied them, showcasing our best handwriting. In Maths, Y3 have been adding and subtracting 1's, 10's and 100's. Y4 have been working on subtracting with exchanges and using the inverse operation to check they have the right answer. We have also looked at 'fact families'. Please continue to encourage your children to practise the recall of their times tables as much as possible. They underpin many areas of Mathematics! In Geography this week, we have loved creating 'facts files' about the Democratic Republic of Africa.

Deva Roman Experience and soldier patrol - we are super excited about our upcoming historical visit in the new year to enhance our learning. Please, if you have not already done so, log into your child's ParentPay account and give permission for them to join us! 'Sin, Dex, Sin, Dex!'

Year 5 & 6 - In English this week, the Y5/6 children have worked incredibly hard planning and writing their extended piece of writing for Autumn 1. They have been writing their own versions of 'The Golden Pen' story and we have been really impressed with their fantastic plots and application of their mastery keys. In Maths this week, Y5 have investigated square, cube and prime numbers and they have begun work on multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000. Y6, meanwhile, have been resilient as ever, as they have been mastering the formal written method of long division and applying it in different contexts. In Geography, UKS2 have researched and compared the climates of different mountain ranges across the world and they have looked at the adverse effects of certain mountain climates, such as experiencing hypothermia. In D.T, the Y5/6 classes have continued to design their model boats and some classes have got a head start building them. We are very excited to test them out next week!

Just a polite reminder that children should not be playing football (or any other ball games) on the playground before or after school.


Cake Sale!

### Whole School Attendance 95.40% Reporting Children's Absence

School must be informed of children's absence on the first day by ringing 0151 329 3164 and pressing 1 to leave a message. This must be done before 9am. Please ensure you provide the child's name, class and reason for absence.

If your child is absent due to sickness or diarrhoea, they will be unable to return to school for 48hrs after their last episode. This is inline with the Public Health Agency guidance to reduce the risk of the illness spreading. Any absence not explained is registered as unauthorised.

#### **Appointments**

Parents and carers should make every effort to book routine dental and GP appointments outside of school hours. Where this is not possible, children should only be absent for the time needed for the appointment and travel to and from.

For any prebooked medical appointments copies of appointment letters can be emailed to <a href="mailto:n.brown@woodlands.cheshire.sch.uk">n.brown@woodlands.cheshire.sch.uk</a> in advance so that a note can be added to the register. The school will work with all families on an individual basis if medical absences exceed the maximum threshold.



Dear Parents,

I am delighted to inform you that following the success of previous year's courses we are expanding the football coaching programme for the season. The course will run on a weekly basis EVERY MONDAY during school term times.

All of our courses are run by F.A. QUALIFIED COACHES INCLUDING EX-PROFESSIONAL PLAYERS. All of our coaches have been DBS/CRB POLICE CHECKED. The course is open to boys and girls aged between 4 and 12. All abilities are catered for with total beginners introduced through FUN and confidence building practices. The course is tightly structured to ensure all aspects of football skills are developed.

At the end of the term(usually 10-15 weeks) every child will receive an engraved merit trophy and course certificate, with chances to win extra trophies including penalty shoot out, american shoot out and champions league competitions.

The cost of the course is £7.50 per week, which is payable every four weeks (£30) with the first payment due on week one. Parents are welcome to stay and watch however the club is fully supervised so children may be left in our care. We have the use of excellent facilities including the large sports hall and outdoor pitches.
